



We will introduce four new lounges, each repurposed for specific functions. These lounges were officially unveiled by our staff on 20 June 2025.




ORCHARD Lounge



Orchard Lounge is a new addition and is designated as a future Ultra-Premium Lounge with a full clinic setting for specific groups of patients. It is located on Level 1 of the Medical Centre and will double-up as an outpatient space to offer onsite consultation and procedures for such patients in an exclusive and personalised environment.



ELIZABETH Lounge

Elizabeth Lounge is now three times its previous size, situated along the main corridor that links the Grand Lobby to Lobby B and Medical Centre. It overlooks the future Admissions Office and offers scenic views of the Rehabilitation Garden, creating a serene environment for VIP patients to unwind during admissions or between tests.



VICTORIA Lounge

Victoria Lounge has been repurposed as a meeting lounge. It will primarily be used for family conferences and patient counselling purposes. It is now at Level 2 along the new "100m service corridor" adjacent to the Grand Lobby for privacy



Albert Lounge is a recent addition, specifically designed as a VIP waiting and treatment area for our Radiology patients. You can find it within the new Radiology Complex, situated along the new "100m service corridor."
