We are happy to announce that all wards at Mount Elizabeth Hospital (MEH) will be officially operational from Monday, 4 August 2025. Since the opening of our new Ward 5A (Phase 1) in December 2023, we have re-opened 13 new wards the following 18 months. We have re-opened our final five wards on 30 July 2025.

WARD 3C Formerly known as Day Ward

Our newly upgraded Day Ward is now seamlessly connected to our Major Operating Theatre (MOT), with the Day Surgery Operating Theatre (DSOT) subsumed within MOT, creating a single, cohesive space that enhances patient care and workflow efficiency. This facility is now part of our fully redesigned intensive care footprint on Level 3, which includes the ICUs, Neonatal ICU, and Delivery Suites.



Effective 4 August 2025, the administration of Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) and Spravato will be moved to Ward 3C.

For All Day Surgery Admissions:


- Registration will take place at the Level 2 Admission Office.
- Patients should proceed to Ward 3C using Patient Lift Lobby B, traveling from Level 2 to Level 3 until Visitor Lift Lobby B (access between Level 2 to 10) is available in November 2025.
- Patient discharge and payments will be handled directly within Ward 3C at Peony Lounge.



(Phase 2) - Maternity Ward



Our new Maternity Ward is now purposefully configured for maternity care with a fully equipped nursery that oversteps into the future Heritage Garden. Imagine new parents looking at their newborns with the garden as the backdrop! This ward also features the return of Daffodil Suite which is a mirror of the Magnolia Suite.



(Phase 2)


Ward 5B (Phase 2) will integrate with Phase 1 into the full mega Ward 5B as one ward and will have a total of 30 rooms (26 single rooms, 2 negative pressure room and 2 VIP Suite – Magnolia & Tulip Suite. It has the same layout and workflows as the other general wards unveiled previously.

Ward 5C features 5 single rooms, 4 four-bedded rooms and 2 specialised Radionuclide Therapy Rooms for safe administration of radioactive isotopes. Each of these Isotope room is built with specialised shielding and strict radiation safety controls, meeting National Environmental Agency (NEA) regulations.


